1. Yearly Financial Report Comparison Presented. From July 2010 – through to present.
2. 2016 – 2017 Tentative competition Schedule Presented.
3. Recommendation to open a new Board Member position.

4. Cassie Rice Noted: Mobility Chart is helpful and will be used to continuously track mobility and document possible infractions.
5. Nevada Handbook Corrections and additions:
  - 5.1 Bidding Procedure (page 7 of the Nevada Handbook)
    - A. In order to have priority bidding, any team that has not yet hosted a State Meet must bid by **June 1st**, directly to the SACC. (see below for past meet hosts)
    - B. All other bid submissions, including those from a prior host, may be received no later than **June 30th**. The NWGA Board voting shall be completed by **July 15th** (of the year preceding the event hosted). There are no restrictions, at this time, on hosting consecutive State Meets.
  - 5.2 NWGA Membership and Dues (page 5 of the Nevada Handbook)  
Membership to NWGA is a **\$200 fee with an increase of \$20 every 5 years starting with 2020**, payable to the SACC before or at the Spring State Meet Each Year.  
Board Members Compensation of **\$50 This shall go up by \$5 every 5 years starting in 2020**.  
Those changes will be in effect from September 2016.

6. NWGA Revenue:
  - 6.1 Recommendation to charge Nevada Athletes a registration fee of \$4 (four dollars) per gymnast. To be payable by Member Clubs by September 15<sup>th</sup> 2016.

6.2 Recommendation to charge Nevada Athletes an additional \$2 (two dollars) to be added to State Meet Entry Fees.

7 State Meet Format regulations & recommendations:

7.1 Event Admission Fees are not to exceed maximum recommended by USAG.  
Considerations should be given for type of Venue and meet size.

7.2 Bids and Selection of State Competition Hosts:

Action: Nevada criterion for selection of competition hosts to be created, informed and observed. These criteria to be in addition to the criteria listed in the USAG Rules and Policies 2015 – 2016.

In the announcement for bids – we will tell bidders that choices will be made based on the venue size/costs and gifts proposed and requirements for hosting will be listed in awarding the bid.

7.3 Awards shall be given at the minimum of 50% per age group, this includes team awards, for all levels.

7.4 Level 2's & Bronze - Will now be treated exactly as all compulsory levels and Xcel for awards, team awards & entry fee.

7.5 No floating meet judge for level 2 and Xcel necessary.

7.6 Deadline for entries and notice of scratches:

30 days out full refund

25 days out half refund

14 days out NO refund (According to Nevada Handbook – Page 9)

7.7 A State Meet Assistant will be assigned by the SACC if she deems necessary. This position will be responsible for working with the meet host so everything runs smoothly and warrants a payment of \$500 (dollars).
